NHRS Employer Notification

Pursuant to RSA 100-A:14, XII, the New Hampshire Retirement System (NHRS) is issuing this notice to inform NHRS participating employers about legislation that may have a cost impact on employers.

The following legislation has been introduced as of January 9, 2012. NHRS will send further notifications if additional legislation with a financial impact is introduced.

HB 654	Relative to credit for retirement system employer contribution overpayments.
HB 1306	Requiring retirement system employers to make contributions for part-time employment of retired members of the retirement system.
HB 1483	Repealing the retirement system special account.
SB 228	Repealing the assessments for excess benefits paid by employers in the retirement system.
SB 229	Establishing a defined contribution retirement plan for public employees.
SB 230	Relative to the calculation of average final compensation in the retirement system.
SB 244	Relative to administration of the New Hampshire retirement system.
SB 246	Revising the calculation of retirement system employer assessments for excess benefits.
SB 249	Requiring a request for proposals for the administration and management of the New Hampshire retirement system.
SB 362	Relative to benefits related to service of certain part-time judges of probate retiring because of permanent disability.
