Statements provide personal account information for members

CONCORD, N.H. – The Fiscal Year 2011 Annual Member Statements have been mailed to all New Hampshire Retirement System (NHRS, the System) members who are not yet retired.

The annual statement provides important personal data about member accounts including service, salary, and beneficiary information. An informational insert was included with the mailing to explain how to read the statement and to describe the NHRS benefit provisions.

NHRS administers a defined benefit plan qualified as a tax-exempt entity under section 401(a) and 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code.
