

Salary Variance Exceeded

This exception will appear if a member's reported wages have significantly increased from their previously reported wages. It is triggered when the reported wages reach or exceed 500% of the prior wages reported.

This generally occurs if the member receives any payouts, balloon checks, severance packages, settlement pay, etc. or if a new member receives a small first paycheck.
