

TERMINATION OF BENEFIT OPTION OF DEATH (PRIMARY) BENEFICIARY Greater than 120 days post-retirement for divorce

SECTION I – DIVORCE FROM PRIMARY BENEFICIARY

A retiree who becomes divorced may cancel his/her beneficiary option pursuant to RSA 100-A:13, II under one of the following two conditions:

- 1. If the former spouse remarries and proof of the remarriage is submitted.
- 2. If the final divorce decree or final settlement agreement mandates that the former spouse renounce his or her right to the pension benefit and a copy of the decree or final settlement showing the mandate to renounce is submitted.

Such termination shall become effective on the first day of the month following receipt of this form and supporting documentation by NHRS.

Upon termination of the beneficiary option, the retiree will begin receiving the Maximum Retirement Allowance and cannot designate a survivorship option to another beneficiary.
